

Ties in Competitions 2017

Ties: The manner in which halved matches or ties are to be decided must be announced before the competition begins.

[Ties in 18 hole Stableford & Par events \(includes 4BBB Stableford, & Irish 4 ball Stableford\).](#)

For 18 hole events the best stableford score for the last 9 holes on the card shall be used; if there is still a tie the last 6 holes or if still tied the last 3 holes. If a tie still persists then use the same method on the front 9. If still tied go hole by hole from 18 backwards.

In 27, 36, 54 or 72 hole events the 18 hole card for the last round will be used. If still tied count back as above.

[Ties in 18 hole Stroke Competitions involving Nett scores.](#)

On the matched cards, total the score on the last 9 holes & deduct $\frac{1}{2}$ of the handicap from the gross score to give the nett score for the last 9 holes. The lowest Nett score is the winner on a count back. Below are the fractions of handicap to be deducted from the gross score of the last 9 holes, 6 holes, 3 holes, etc.

$\frac{1}{2}$ the handicap for the last 9 holes

$\frac{1}{3}$ the handicap for the last 6 holes

One sixth the handicap for the last 3 holes

One eighteenth the handicap hole by hole from 18th

[Ties in 18 hole Ambrose, Aggregate Stableford, and Foursome, plus Canadian 2 Stroke Competitions involving Nett scores.](#)

Prizes for tied scores will be shared.

In an event that has prizes of: 1st (\$40), 2nd (\$25), 3rd (\$15).

Eg. Tie between 1st, 2nd, & 3rd, \$25 rounded down will go to each player.

Eg. Tie between 1st & 2nd, \$30 to each player of both teams.

Eg. Tie between 2nd & 3rd, \$20 to each player of both teams.

[Ties in 36 hole events.](#)

Ties for **Gross** events will be decided by a play off on holes 1,17 and 18. If no result is achieved there will be a sudden death hole by hole play off on holes 1, 17 and 18 in that order.

Ties in **Nett** scores will be decided in accordance with the Australian Countback System. For a 36 hole Nett event, compare scores for the last 18 holes and if still tied, compare scores for the last 9, then 6, then 3.

Below are the fractions of handicap to be deducted from the gross score of the last 9 holes, 6 holes, 3 holes, etc.

$\frac{1}{2}$ the handicap for the last 9 holes

$\frac{1}{3}$ the handicap for the last 6 holes

One sixth the handicap for the last 3 holes

One eighteenth the handicap hole by hole from 18th.
