1. 1st – remove branches that impact drives from tee. Some have been removed (J15); others will require “cherry-picker” and professional operator/s. Needed on high branches 1st, 2nd, 5th near tee, 7th, 15th and 18th (P6) Consider three mounds RHS of fairway in time (???)
2. 2nd - Couple of large trees marked, need to decide whether we drop these or trim fairway side. Several smaller trees have been removed LHS to allow access of mowers. (J15)
3. 3rd – two small trees LHS of usual place for white tees have been removed along with two others that have overhanging branches RHS just before the creek (J15). Two others there have been left, as branches are away from fairway. Tree next to green will be trimmed right back or removed (J15). Need to contact Brad Lavender about reinforcing bridge (Project P5 - Upgrade/Replace 3rd Tee Bridge - As a Project this needs to go through the project process – first step get approval for INITIATION); some work had commenced.
4. 4th – general trimming. Commenced last Tuesday (J15)
5. 5th – need to trim branches and if necessary take out one tree to allow use of back of tee-block. See if we can do in-house. (J18)
6. 6th – proposed tiger tee. Agreed not a priority at this stage. (Project P4 – Create Tiger Tee at 6th)
7. 7th – not able to see LHS of green. A working-bee addressed this by clearing smaller and medium trees LHS of creek. Some smaller trees RHS marked for removal to improve mower access. Removal of nuisance tree behind green to allow mowing. These trees not normally in play.(J15)
8. 8th - LHS. Some smaller trees marked for removal. Emphasis not to make course easier, but to give access to rough mowers (J15).

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9. 9th – RHS. Some smaller trees marked for removal. Underbrush to be cleared through to 14th green (J15)
10. 10th- OK, but Greens Staff have problem with too much soil moisture at back of green. Clear up lake surrounds and undergrowth to allow airflow (J15) OK to shorten green by 5m. Review when green re-constructed.(Project P10 – Green Reconstruction – 10th)
11. 11th – totally remove trees around Lake LHS ~ 100m from tee and clear up (J15) Working bee planned. Garden on RHS of green (on hill) to be considered later (Project P11 – Construct Mound Garden RHS 11th Green)
12. 12th – the need for access to this green for reconstruction was discussed. Too hard coming down easement. Found a suitable path between lakes. Need to take out one tree (not in play), build drain and trim RHS of trees going to green.(Project P12 – Reconstruct Green 12th)
13. 13th – OK
14. 14th – second shot LHS, Some smaller trees marked for removal. Again emphasis on mower access. Need to ensure does not unduly make hole easier. (J15)
15. 15th - undergrowth LHS near creek to be cleared, as elsewhere to raise tree canopy. (J15)
16. 16th – thin branches both sides of tee to allow use of back of tee (J18). Considered open drain between 16th and 2nd fairways, deep enough to flow into creek both ends. Lateral drains to remove surface water on fairways into open drain. In wet season this relatively deep open drain will contain water – so make water hazard almost to green 2nd and drain to creek. Deco paths between fairways, appropriate drainage below. (Project P7 – Open Drain Between 2nd and 16th)
17. 17th – level ladies tee (Project P8 – Level Tee Blocks)
18. 18th – remove one tree LHS of tee near memorial garden (J15). Consider project proposed in consultation with Course Superintendent - mounds RHS of fairway in front of ladies tee, with deco path meandering through them, finishing large tree. Job for volunteers working with Greens staff. Rye grass to be seeded over bare patches (after aeration and gypsum, lime, NPK). To improve appearance from road. It will die out with hot weather, but will provide medium for rolled couch or couch seed in early summer (Project P9 – Mounding and Pathway – 18th).
