### **Course News as at 22/10/2012 - Spring!**

Well renovations are over for another *Spring*, the greens are starting to come back well.



They are very very green! I think this has been one of our best renovations ever. With the new machines we were able to punch more holes than usual and go a lot deeper into the soil profile.

We mixed a special prescription blend of organics through our sand this year to help get organics down into the profile which is what is giving us so much colour. We are bringing

the cutting height back down to *4mm* this week and rolling regularly to get some pace back.

When there is soft, lush, new growth like this, the turf tends to be injured easily, just take care and repair your ball marks.

As you've probably noticed the water levels are getting very low. We are just easing off watering fairway and rough areas and cutting back on tees a little to ensure we last through this dry period although I think we'll be fine. Plans are back in place to have a bore installed and this will hopefully be happening very soon.



I hope everyone is making the most of the dry weather and getting out for a hit, remember rain is never too far away on the Sunshine Coast!
