Cooroy Golf Club – Pace of Play Policy (P.P.P.)

The maximum considered time to complete a round of golf at Cooroy Golf Club is 4 hrs 20 mins. The first nine holes should be completed in 2 hrs and the 2^{nd} none holes in 2 hrs 20 mins.

- 1. A group of players is "out of position" when they are travelling at a pace outside the considered time.
- 2. A group is out of position when they have lost time on their "starting time interval" relevant to the group ahead.
- 3. A group (or individual) can be monitored or timed at any stage of their round by the Match Committee or its appointee.

Penalties for failure to comply with the P.P.P. are:

- A warning they (or he/she) are in breach of the P.P.P. for recording a bad time (out of position).
- A one stroke penalty for recording a bad time.
- A two stroke penalty for recording a further bad time.
- **Disqualification** for the failure to correct the breach of the P.P.P. (further bad time).

NOTES:

- 1. A player has 40 seconds to play his/her shot (50 seconds for the first to play).
- 2. A player has three minutes only to search for a lost ball.
- 3. Timing on any given shot commences when a player has had sufficient time to reach his/her ball when it is his/her turn to play and he/she is able to play without interference and distraction.
- 4. On the putting green the "time spent" looking at the line from behind or beyond the line, and aligning the ball, will count in the 40 seconds.
- 5. A group moving excessively quickly or deemed to be harassing another group (or individual) who are within the P.P.P. will be considered to breach not only the P.P.P but also the Code of Conduct Policy of the Club.
