

CGC Covid-Safe Rules Update – March 2021

Dear Members and Visitors,

With the release of the new Qld Chief Health Officer Direction on March 13th, some of the regulations governing the club have changed. Some on-course rules have also been changed to make CGC rules more consistent with current practice at other local golf clubs.

As a reminder to members and visitors, here is the current state of the Covid-safe rules in place at Cooroy Gold Club.

Clubhouse

- The clubhouse is limited to a maximum of 86 patrons. This includes the outside deck area.
- 1.5 m social distancing must be maintained at the bar and between seated groups.
- Sign-in is required. Those patrons with smartphones are requested to download and use the Check In Qld app. Those without smartphones must record name, phone number and email address on the hand-written register at the bar.

On the course

- Pool noodles remain on the base of each flag stick. CGC strongly recommends that players do not remove the flag when putting and must not ask or expect another player to remove or hold the flag for them.
- Rakes have been removed the bunkers. Preferred lie in the bunkers is allowed.
- In the interest of player health in warm weather, the two drinking taps on the course are available for the filling of water bottles only. Do not drink directly from the tap. The bubblers will remain out of use. After using the tap please use hand sanitiser.
- Ball washers can be used at a player's discretion but the hand sanitiser provided must be used afterwards.
- Flag sticks will be sanitised by the greens staff each time they mow the greens.

The CGC management continues to regularly monitor the Qld Chief Health Office Directions and Golf Australia recommendations. In the interest of Covid-safe personal hygiene, Golf Australia and the CGC Management Committee continue to recommend that players <u>do not touch</u> the flag sticks.

Please continue to maintain 1.5 m social distancing and good Covid-19 personal hygiene.
